

# Container Vegetables 2010

## Tomatoes

**Better Bush** VFFNAST -(68 Days) Compact, short internode growth habit. 4" tomatoes 8-11 oz. Excellent for large containers or the small garden. Indeterminate Short Internode

**Bush Celebrity** VFFNTAST-(67 Days) Abundant 8-9 oz. Tomatoes on compact plants. Great Celebrity flavor that balance sugars and acids. Determinate

**Bush Early Girl Hybrid**-(54 Days) Compact, patio-sized variety; huge yields of firm, meaty Flavorful tomatoes. Determinate

**Bush Goliath** VFN-(68 Days) Perfect for the patio gardeners or those with limited space. Grows About 3.5' tall. Produces 3"-4" tomatoes, flavorful, high sugar content. Determinate

**Husky Cherry Red Hybrid** VFA-(65 Days) All season-long production of 1" tomatoes with excellent Flavor. Perfect for small spaces or large containers. Determinate

**Patio Kabob** VF-(65 Days) Only need an 8"-10" pot as plants grow to about 18" tall, but are loaded With ping pong ball sized tomatoes. Great for the skewer!

**Patio Picnic** VF-(65 Days) Great for containers or small space gardening. Grows 2 feet tall. Produces bunches of firm, round red 4 oz. tomatoes. Determinate

**Patio Teacup Red** VF-(62 Days) Compact, bushy plant that only grows 6"-8" tall. Fits well into an 8" Container on the patio. Produces red, large, sweet grape sized tomatoes.

**Patio Teacup Yellow** VF-(62 Days) Compact, bushy plants that only grow 6"-8" tall. Fits well into an 8" container on the patio. Produces yellow, large, sweet grape sized tomatoes.

## Peppers

**Apache Red Chili**-(65 Days) HOT A delightful dwarf Chile pepper for the patio container. Produces 3" long peppers all summer. Matures green to red.

**Patio Tasty Hotwings**-(71 Days) HOT Produces 1.5" x .75" peppers on plants easily grown in a Container. Use in kabobs, salsa and wing sauces. Matures green to red.

**Redskin Hybrid**-(65 Days) SWEET Perfect for a 10" container, grows 16" tall, producing sweet red Bell peppers 4" long all summer. Matures green to red.

## Eggplant

**Hansel Hybrid**-(55 Days) Produces clusters of dark purple fruit, with few seeds, harvest at 3" to 10" In length. Plants are compact less than 3' tall.

**Gretel Hybrid**-(55 Days) Produces clusters of pure white fruit, with few seeds, harvest at 3" to 10" In length. Compact plant, fine for the patio.

## Okra

**Little Lucy Hybrid**-(55 Days) First ever dwarf red okra. Plants grow 2 feet all, producing 4" okra held above maroon foliage. Grow in a large container or the garden.

**Consider growing lettuce, radishes and onions in a large container also.**

# Herb List for 2010

**Basil-Cardinal**—*Annual* Beautiful standout in the herb garden and flavorful addition to a flower garden. Attractive tight packed blooms in cardinal red, rich heady scent with a touch of spice. Deep burgundy stems.

**Basil-Cinnamon**—*Annual* Distinctive cinnamon colored stems, purple flowers and dark green leaves. Pleasant sweet scent. Slight cinnamon taste. Use fresh or dried.

**Basil-Genovese**—*Annual* A favorite for authentic Italian basil flavor and appearance. Tall, 24-30" with large dark green leaves about 3" long.

**Basil-Italian Large Leaf**—*Annual* A sweeter pesto type with high yields. Tall, 24-30", medium-dark green leaves up to 4" long. Compared to Genovese, scent and taste are sweeter less clove-like.

**Basil-Key Lime**—*Annual* Distinct zesty aroma of lime. Adds a unique citrus flair to fish and salads. Compact plant, leaves 2" long, grows 16-20" tall.

**Basil-Lettuce-leaved**—*Annual* Produces large, crinkled foliage and lots of it. Not strong scented. Grows 24" tall.

**Basil-Mrs. Burns Lemon**—*Annual* The best tasting lemon basil, with a sweet, tangy flavor. Bright Green 2.5" leaves with white flowers. Attractive and flavorful. Grows 20-24" tall.

**Basil-Osmin Purple**—*Annual* Dark purple leaves with a sweet, fruity aroma. Glossy, slightly ruffled 2" leaves with contrasting pale lilac flowers. Grows 16-20" tall.

**Basil-Minnette**—*Annual* Attractive, bushy, very small-leaved and grows in a tight, compact shape. Excellent for a container on the patio or in a pot inside by a sunny window. Grows 10" tall.

**Basil-Purple Ruffles**—*Annual* Large, ruffled leaves. Good for garnishes or as an ornamental garden plant. Grows 16-20" tall.

**Basil-Red Rubin**—*Annual* Vigorous, purple, Italian large leaf type. High yields and great flavor. Flat, 3" long leaves, copper-tinged purple color. Grows 18-24" tall.

**Basil-Spicy Globe**—*Annual* Small, dome-shaped plants with smaller leaves. Decorative plants can be Grown in pots or used in flower beds. Grows 8-14" tall.

**Basil-Thai Magic**—*Annual* Mild, sweet flavor with a hint of anise. Shiny, thick green leaves 3" long. Brilliant magenta flower clusters—fantastic for ornamental use. Grows 18-22" tall.

**Catnip**—*Perennial* Vigorous, high-yielding plants. Cat-attracting with gray-green leaves and white Flowers. Grows 18-24" tall. Hardy Zone 3-9.

**Catnip-Lemony**—*Perennial* Looks exactly like true catnip, but is lemon scented and can be used like Lemon balm. Use in teas, sachets, soups, or a treat for the cat. Grows 18-24" tall.

**Chamomile-Roman**—*Perennial* Aromatic, ground cover that will tolerate light foot traffic. Has similar uses for teas as annual varieties, but produces fewer blossoms. Grows 10-16\_ tall.

**Chives**—*Perennial* Mild onion flavor. Leaves are a key culinary herb, while the attractive globe-shaped blooms are used as an edible garnish. Grows 18" tall.

**Chives-Garlic**—*Perennial* Produces thin, flat leaves that have a delicate garlic flavor, It blooms white flowers in midsummer. Grows 15"-18" tall.

**Cilantro-Calypso**—*Annual* A classic Mexican herb. A variety that is slow-bolting. Need to plant seed every 2 weeks for a continuous supply of fresh leaves. Grows 12"-18" tall.

**Cilantro Xiang Cai**—*Annual* Slow-bolting Asian variety that produces large, full plants. Classic cilantro appearance and flavor. Grows 12"-18" tall.

**Cutting Celery**—*Annual* Leafy herb with bold celery flavor. Use fresh in salads, cooked in soups, Stews, or with vegetables. Grows 18" tall.

**Dill-Bouquet**—*Annual* Produces edible seeds and greens to flavor many foods. A must for making Pickles! Foliage known as dill weed. Grows 38"-42" tall.

**Fennel-Bronze**—*Tender Perennial (reseeds)* Gorgeous reddish-bronze color in the foliage. Vigorous uniform variety that is slow to bolt (go to seed). Leaves have a sweet flavor, nice addition to salads, cole slaw, and dressings. Non-bulbing type. Grows 24-36" tall.

**Lavender-Ellagance Purple**—*Perennial* A bushy, well-branched variety producing large, dense flower Spikes. Use as cut flower, dried, or borders. Attracts butterflies. Grows 12"-14" tall

**Lavender-French**—*Perennial* Features fragrant dark violet flowers. A great accent plant with fine, silvery foliage. Use in borders, pots, as a cut flower, or in potpourri. Grows 36" tall.

**Lavender-Grosso**—*Perennial* Extremely fragrant deep violet flowers atop attractive silver green foliage. A butterfly magnet Grows 24" tall.

**Lavender-Hidcote Blue**—*Perennial* Attractive dark purple flowers above a dense mound of fine-leaved, silvery, aromatic foliage. Use in borders, a garden accent, fresh or dried. Grows 12-18" tall.

**Lavender-Lady**—*Perennial* Aromatic, beautiful silvery foliage and deep lavender-blue flowers. Use in borders, a garden accent, fresh or dried. Grows 18" tall.

**Lavender-Lavance Purple**—*Perennial* Naturally compact, deep purple flowers. Blooms all season Long. Enjoy in a container on the patio. Grows 10" tall.

**Lavender-Munstead**—*Perennial* Plants are aromatic, compact, with silvery foliage and deep lavender blue flowers. Use in borders rock gardens, fresh or dried. Grows 12"-18" tall.

**Lavender-Nina Purple**—*Tender Perennial* Naturally compact, heat tolerant with lost of small flowers. Perfect for pots, rock garden. Grows 9"-15" tall.

- Lemon Balm**—*Perennial* Attractive plant that produces abundant supply of lemony, fresh leaves for tea and salads. Easy to grow. Grows 18"-26" tall.
- Lemon Grass**—*Annual* Aromatic grass from India. Used for flavorings and perfumes. Grow in a container if you do not want it to freeze in winter. Grows 36" tall.
- Lemon Verbena**—*Annual* A wonderful smelling herb with long, narrow leaves, white flowers. A strong lemon fragrance and flavor. Use in drinks, jams, fruit salads and potpourri. Grows 36" tall.
- Marjoram**—*Annual* An elegant and versatile culinary herb. Aroma is similar to oregano, but sweeter and more balsam-like. Grows 10"-24" tall.
- Mint-Apple**—*Perennial* Soft, gray-green round leaves have a fruity fragrance and apple flavor. Use in borders, drinks, candies and vegetables. Grows 24"-36" tall.
- Mint-Candy mint**—*Perennial* Sweet **peppermint** scented foliage that has reddish stems. Use in teas, jellies, and desserts. Grows 18"-24" tall and 30" wide.
- Mint-Chocolate**—*Perennial* Features dark leaves, purple stems and lavender flowers. Delightful peppermint patty fragrance and flavor. Use in borders, drinks, candy. Grows 24" tall.
- Mint-Orange**—*Perennial* Attractive green foliage with red veins, a delightful citrus flavor and aroma. Use in borders, potpourri, drinks, candies and vegetables. Grows 24" tall.
- Mint-The Best**—*Perennial* A stronger, sweeter **spearmint** aroma and flavor. Truly the "best" culinary mint. Use in pots, teas, jellies, and desserts. Invasive. Grows 24" tall and 36" wide.
- Oregano-Cuban**—*Annual* Attractive, highly scented green fuzzy foliage plants. In the plectranthus plant family. Use as addition to any container. Grows 24" tall and 18" wide.
- Oregano-Greek**—*Perennial* Heavy oregano aroma; great for pizza and Italian cooking. Characteristic dark green leaves with white flowers. Use fresh or dried in stews, fish, and meats. Grows 24"
- Oregano-Hot & Spicy**—*Perennial* Thought to be the best oregano for cooking with its bold flavor. creeping growth habit. Grows 12" tall.
- Oregano-Mexican**—*Annual* Ornamental plant that produces clusters of showy pink, long, tubular flowers above the foliage. Used in flavorings. In the *poliomintha* plant family. Grows 36" tall.
- Parsley-Italian Large Leaf**—*Biannual* Flat, glossy, dark green leaves have a strong parsley/celery flavor for use fresh or dried. Grows 18-20" tall.
- Parsley-Starke (Curley)**—*Biannual* Intense curled leaves make exceptionally beautiful garnishes. Mild flavor, good yields. Grows 14-16" tall.
- Rosemary**—*Tender Perennial* Needle like leaves with a soft pine aroma Use fresh or dried in a variety of dishes. Grows 30" t
- Rosemary-Pine-Scented**—*Tender Perennial* Upright growth habit. Distinctive, strong pine scent. Wonderful plant. Grows 24" tall.

**Rue**—*Perennial* Lacy blue-green ornamental plant. Bushy growth habit, pungent aroma. A favorite for the butterfly larvae to feed on. Grows 24"-36" tall.

**Sage-Garden**—*Perennial* Handsome, dusty green leaves. Use in dressings, sausage, sauces, and Tea. Makes a good base for dried wreaths. Grows 16"-30" tall.

**Sage-Gold Variegated**—*Tender perennial* Long, oval green and gold leaves. Blooms lavender-blue flowers. A milder flavor than the standard sage. Grows 24' tall

**Sage-Pineapple**—*Annual* This plant has a shrubby growth habit with attractive scarlet flowers and wonderful pineapple scented leaves. Butterflies and hummingbirds love it! Grows 24" tall.

**Sage-Tricolor**—*Tender Perennial* Attractive long, oval, green leaves with pink and white margins. Mauve-blue flowers. Mild flavor. Use fresh or dried in salads and soup. Grows 24" tall.

**Salad Burnet**—*Perennial* Unique leaf shape for salads, garnishes. Mild cucumber flavor. Oval toothed leaflets and deep crimson flower heads. Grows 16-24" tall.

**Savory-Summer**—*Annual* Dark green leaves add a peppery flavor to culinary dishes such as beans, cabbage, and sauerkraut. Grows 10-18" tall.

**Savory-Winter**—*Perennial* The perennial cousin to summer savory, with thicker and shinier leaves. Flavor is more pungent and biting. Use to flavor beans, cabbage. Grows 10-18" tall.

**Scented Geranium-Dr. Livingston**—*Annual* Also call Skeleton Leaf Rose. Has deep cut leaves with a rough, raspy texture and a rose scent.

**Scented Geranium-Fair Ellen**—*Annual* Leaves are slightly lobed with purple-brown midrib markings. Has a strong pungent scent. Low growing oak leaf type and looks good in pots.

**Scented Geranium-Grey Lady Plymouth**—*Annual* Deep divided grey-green leaved edged with white. Lovely rose scent and small lavender flowers.

**Scented Geranium-Lemon**—*Annual* One of the most popular of the lemon-scented geraniums. It has small, roundish, crinkled leaves. Stiff, upright stems, that left unpruned with cascade as they lengthen, making it attractive in a container.

**Scented Geranium-Lime**—*Annual* Has smooth roundish leaves that are slightly ruffled, and sweetly lime scented. Will grow tall and lanky if not pruned frequently. Small pale lavender flowers.

**Scented Geranium-Old Fashioned Rose**—*Annual* Grows to a medium height, with gray-green Strongly indented leaves and a nice rose scent. Blooms small lavender flowers.

**Scented Geranium-Peppermint**—*Annual* A large sprawling plant with large, lobed leaves with a wonderfully soft, velvety texture. Quickly fills a container. Prefers afternoon shade.

**Scented Geranium-Pungent Peppermint**—*Annual* Plant has deep cut gray-green leaves. Grows to a medium size and has a nice mint scent and mauve flowers.

**Scented Geranium-Snowflake Rose**—*Annual* Attractive large, slightly fuzzy leaves have a hit-or-miss white variegation. Good choice for large containers. Has a lemon-rose scent.

**Spilanthes**—*Annual* Also called the “toothache plant: as chewing on a leaf will numb your mouth for several minutes. A fun ornamental that blooms olive-shaped golden yellow flowers with a deep burgundy red eye. Attractive bronze foliage. Grows 12”-15” tall.

**Stevia**—*Annual* Incredibly sweet leaves are an herbal alternative to sugar. Use fresh or dried, to sweeten food. Bushy, high yielding plants. Grows 18”-30” tall.

**Tarragon-French**—*Annual* Features narrow, dark green leaves with a mild, anise like flavor. Use Fresh, dried or frozen to flavor vinegars, sauces, meats and eggs. Grows 36”

**Thymus-German Winter**—*Perennial* Classic culinary and ornamental herb. Small, round to needle-shaped, evergreen leaves on woody stems. Good flavor and yields. Grows 8-12” tall.

**Thymus-Highland Crème**—*Perennial* Attractive fragrant cream and green, variegated, evergreen foliage. Showy, white-pink flowers. Use as edging or ground cover. Grows 2-3” tall.

**Thymus-Lemon**—*Perennial* Attractive tiny, light green leaves with lemon scent. Small clusters of tiny pink flowers. Use as ground cover, in rock gardens, or for edging. Grows 12” tall.

**Thymus-Minus**—*Perennial* Fragrant evergreen foliage and showy light pink flowers. Use as a ground cover or between stepping stones. Grows 1” tall.

**Thyme-Orange**—*Perennial* A citrusy scented thyme to use with fish and vegetables, stews, marmalades, or chutney. The strong orange scent is flavorful but not bitter. Great in the kitchen or the garden. Grows 8-12” tall.

**Thyme-Porlock**—*Perennial* Excellent for both cooking and pathways. Wonderfully scented, and Has neat, shrubby growth. Grows 2” tall and 18” wide.

**Thymus-Red Creeping**—*Perennial* Blooms reddish-pink flowers on mat forming, smooth dark leaves of sweetly scented foliage. Excellent used as a ground cover. Grows 4” tall.

**Thymus-Silver**—*Perennial* Features a shrubby growth habit of tiny leaves edged in silver. Use as a low border for the herb, vegetable or flower garden. Grows 12” tall.

**Thymus Wedgewood**—*Perennial* Aromatic, dark green leaves accented with chartreuse center. Use along walkways or trailing over combination planters. Grows 6”-8” tall and 18”-24” wide.

**Thymus-Woolly**—*Perennial* Attractive dense, silver-grey, wooly foliage provides a mat-like covering Use as a ground cover, in rock gardens and between stepping stones. Grows 2-4” tall.

# Tomato Variety List for 2010

**Indeterminate:** Tomato varieties that blossom and set tomatoes progressively, and the harvest lasts for several months. These varieties are best when staked or caged.

**Determinate:** Tomato varieties that are bush type or space-saving in the garden. Plants blossom and develop tomatoes on the vine at the same time. Tomatoes produced over a 4-6 week period. Best to cage.

**Abe Lincoln**—(87 Days ) Dark red tomatoes, sweet, solid and meaty. Free from cracks. **Indeterminate**

**Amish Paste**—(74-85 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Produces acorn shaped deep red tomatoes, 8 oz. with thick flesh, and few seeds. Indeterminate

**Arkansas Traveler**—(80-90 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Smooth rose colored tomatoes, mild flavor, juicy, heat and humidity tolerant, crack and disease resistant. Indeterminate

**Baby Cakes Hybrid**—(70 Days) A beautiful large red cherry tomato variety with fantastic eating quality; Produces 1.5" tomatoes, deep red, natural salty flavor. Determinate

**Beefmaster Hybrid VFNASt**—(80 Days) Popular hybrid beefsteak type, good disease resistance solid, meaty tomatoes up to 2#. Resists cracking. Indeterminate

**Beefy Boy Hybrid VFFTSt**—(70 Days) Meaty, extra-large main-season beefsteak type with great taste. Solid 12 oz.-16 oz. deep red tomatoes. Heavy yields. Indeterminate

**Better Boy Hybrid VFNASt**—(75 Days) Great midseason variety, deep red tomatoes up to 1#. Juicy, yet firm tomatoes. Excellent disease resistance. Indeterminate

**Better Bush** VFFNASt—(68 Days) Compact, short internode growth habit. 4" tomatoes weighting 8-11 oz. Excellent choice for large containers or the small garden. Indeterminate Short Internode

**Black Krim**—(69 Days) *HEIRLOOM* A most unusual novelty. Tomatoes are a dark, deep red (almost a shiny black) with heavy green shoulders. Sweet and tasty. Indeterminate

**Black Pearl**—(65 Days) Fresh off the vine real tasty, but once refrigerated it has a unique, extra Sweet 'Concord' grape flavor. High yields. Indeterminate

**Big Beef** VFFNTAST—(73 Days) Old fashioned rich flavor with bred-in hybrid qualities of large tomato size and yield, uniformity and good disease resistance. Indeterminate

**Big Mama**—(80 Days) Enormous, incredibly meaty tomatoes, up to 5"long and 3" across. Great for sauces, practically seedless. Indeterminate

**Brandywine**—(90-100 Days) *HEIRLOOM* An Amish heirloom that dates back to 1885. Plants look like potato vines. Good yields, 1.5# lt. rosy pink tomatoes. Indeterminate

**Burpee's Big Boy Hybrid**—(78 Days) Large, crack-free tomato with absolute superb flavor. Bright red firm, meaty tomatoes 1 pound or more. Indeterminate

**Bush Celebrity Hybrid** VFFNTAS<sup>t</sup>—(67 Days) Abundant 8-9 oz. tomatoes on compact plants. Great Celecbrity flavor that balances sugars and acids. Determinate

**Bush Early Girl Hybrid** VFFNT—(54 Days) Compact, patio-sized variety; huge yields of firm, meaty, flavorful tomatoes. Determinate

**Bush Goliath Hybrid** VFN—(68 Days) Perfect for the patio gardeners or those with limited space. Grows 3.5' tall, producing 3-4" tomatoes that are flavorful, high sugar content. Determinate

**Carolina Gold Hybrid VFF**—(71 Days) Extra-large yellow-gold tomatoes with deep oblate shape KSU recommended variety. Vigorous plants. Determinate

**Caspian Pink**—(80 Days) *HEIRLOOM* A taste that may be better than Brandywine! Thin, light red skin, juicy flavor. Indeterminate

**Celebrity Hybrid** VFFNTAS<sup>t</sup>—(70 Days) All America Selections Award winner. Medium-sized, globe-shaped tomatoes are crack resistant, averaging 7 oz. Recommended by KSU. Determinate

**Champion Hybrid** VFNT—(62 Days) One of the earliest full-sized tomatoes. Flavorful and prolific, the 6-8 oz. round tomatoes are solid, meaty and very sweet. Indeterminate

**Cherokee Purple**—(80-90 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Reliable producer of unusual, medium pink-purple tomatoes that appear brown in color. Average 8-12 oz. Flavorful. Indeterminate

**Chocolate Cherry**—(70 Days) Extremely flavorful, round 1" tomatoes; resists cracking, dark chocolate red in color. Great for salads. Indeterminate

**Cupid Hybrid** FAS<sup>t</sup>—(66 Days) *GRAPE TOMATO* A very sweet tasting 1" tomato that resists cracking, and holds up well after harvest. Indeterminate

**Early Cascade Hybrid** VAS<sup>t</sup>—(50 Days) Strong cascading plants produce clusters of smooth, red 4 oz. tomatoes all summer. Fine flavor, easy peeling for canning. Indeterminate

**Early Girl Hybrid** VFF—(57 Days) Meaty, tasty 4-6 oz. tomatoes that have a firm texture, blemish resistant skin. Heavy yields. Indeterminate

**Early Goliath Hybrid** VFFNTAS<sup>t</sup>—(58 Days) Tomato with superb size, perfect shape, continuous production, luscious flavor and broad disease resistance. Indeterminate

**Fantastic Hybrid** VF—(65 Days) Globe-shaped, scarlet red, 3-5" medium-sized tomatoes are almost crack-free. Rich beefsteak flavor, heavy yields, excellent for canning. Indeterminate

**Fourth of July**—(49 Days) Tasty tomatoes, big enough for slicing. Juicy yet firm. Perfect for summer picnics. Size is 2.5" across. Indeterminate

- Giant Belgium**—(80 Days) *HEIRLOOM* Huge, sweet tomatoes average 1-2#. Dark pink, low acid mild flavor, very solid. Indeterminate
- Goliath Hybrid** VFFNTAS—(65 Days) Smooth bright-red, deep oblate tomatoes averaging 10-15 oz. sweet, luscious flavor, high yields. Indeterminate
- Health Kick Hybrid** VFFAS—(72 Days) The perfect saladette variety—fine-flavored. Juicy, plum-shaped tomatoes. Has 50% more lycopene content. High yields. Determinate
- Husky Cherry Red Hybrid** VFA—(65 Days) All season-long production of 1" tomatoes with excellent flavor. Perfect for small spaces or large containers. Determinate
- Jet Star Hybrid** VF—(70 Days) Prolific producer of big, globe-shaped tomatoes. Excellent flavor with low acidity. Recommended by KSU. Very good crack resistance. Indeterminate
- Jetsetter Hybrid**—(66 Days) A hybrid that supercedes Jetstar. Produces a round red, 8 oz. tomato. Superb disease resistance, sets tomatoes continuously till frost. Indeterminate
- Juliet Hybrid**—(60 Days) All America Selections winner. Larger, grape-like tomatoes that don't crack produces clusters of sweet-flavored tomatoes. Indeterminate

**Mandarin Hybrid**—(75 Days) *SWEET* Stunning, deep orange color upon maturity. Peppers are 5"-6" long with firm, medium-thick walls and distinctive, sweet flavor.

**Marichi Hybrid**—(66 Days) *HOT* All America Selection winner. Peppers are low heat under non-stressful conditions. Delicate gourmet flavor, fruity overtones. Peppers are 4" x 2" long.

**Mexibell Hybrid**—(68 Days) *HOT* All America Selection winner. A bell pepper with a mild chili flavor. Produces lots of 3-4 lobed peppers with firm flesh. Matures green to red.
